Notes:
(i) Tang-Yu-zhi-dao was from the Confucian \& Taoist bamboo slips excavated in 1993 at Guodian, Shayang, Hubei. (ii) Shang-shu (Remotely Ancient History) was recompiled after book burning via the oral recital in the early Han dynasty, with chapters related to the thearchs being the late Zhou dynasty products. (iii) Shi-ji was a private history book by Sima Qian of the Western Han dynasty. (iv) Shi4 Jing's reign years were attached to Santong-/i, an epochal calendar designed by Liu Xin of the late Western Han dynasty. (v) Huangfu Mi of the Jinn dynasty adopted the Han dynasty argot \& prophecy books in forging the thearchs' reign years in Di-wang Shi4-ji. (vi) The Bamboo Annals's ancient version mixed up with the Han dynasty argot \& prophecy books that contained the thearchs and dynasties' forged summary years. (vii) Seng Yixing of the Tang dynasty adjusted the precession variance to derive the thearchs' years using Liu Xin's approach and adopted the Sui dynasty sexagenary years that were appended to The Bamboo Annals . (viii) Shao Yong of the Northern Soong dynasty revamped the epochal calendars to forge the thearchs' years using divination and hexagrams in Huang Ji Jing Shi. (ix) Reign years in The Bamboo Annals' contemporary version were forged by Luo Mi of the Southem Soong dynasty on top of the sexagenary years from the Sui dynasty. ( x ) Lu Jinggui extrapolated the thearchs' years by lumping the various forgery numbers. (xi) Y.D. Tse adjusted the forged years in The Bamboo Annals' contemporary version. (xii) The Gap Reign Year Project selectively used the astral sign records. (xiii) Zhang Ruzhou/Zhang Wenyu determined the Zhou dynasty's reign years using a consistent interpretation approach to bronzeware.
